He attributes the problems of attitude to ethnocultural value in the spiritual life of society to the following factors:

- 1. With a deep understanding that independence is a great blessing and value, young people should be deeply aware of their responsibility to the society as a free person and a free citizen, and should become active in their hearts.
- 2. Liberalization of society and spirituality are inextricably linked with democracy and reliance on ethno-cultural values in the worldview of young people. Expressing one's opinion openly and freely about the values related to the present and future of the country, the people, and the nation prevents some negative situations. Above all, it is important to speak freely. By respecting the opinion of young people, relying on the opinion of others, restoring ethno-cultural values, the political and legal culture in the society will rise.
- 3. In a democratic society, the need to restore ethno-cultural values increases, the diversity of opinions and the culture of discussion are formed. Only passing one's own opinion and stifling the opinion of others will end.
- 4. Due to the revival of national and spiritual values, young people value their freedom and independence, treat it with respect, and feel a greater need for this feeling. Certain vices, such as indifference and indifference to cultural heritage, will disappear.
- 5. Today there will be an opportunity to put an end to negative vices that do not correspond to our values.
- 6. In an independent country, it is necessary for every young person to realize his/her identity as a free and independent person, a human being, regardless of what profession he works in. Self-awareness is realized through deep study and careful development of ethno-cultural values.

During the development of independent Uzbekistan from a strong state to a strong society, the correct use of our age-old spiritual heritage, national values, and the historical experiences of our great ancestors, and learning from their exemplary works, will serve the implementation of the tasks of building a civil society in our country, and the spiritual growth of our people. According to the results of a sociological survey conducted by the Public Opinion Research Center of the Republic of Uzbekistan, 46.6% of young people who were asked about the national identity were interested in the customs and traditions of the people, 28.9% were interested in the national independence of Uzbekistan, and 28.4% were interested in the rich history of their people., 21.7 percent said that it is important to rely on the mother tongue and national culture, 19.5 percent on the spiritual identity of their nation, and 16.6 percent on the great heritage of past generations. Thus, the history and traditions of the people of Uzbekistan, national culture, communication between generations, self-awareness and uniqueness are important factors for the youth of Uzbekistan. In the conditions of independence, young people feel the advantage of independence in their life experiences and express confidence in it. Independence is valued as an important condition for realizing national identity and as a factor of self-expression. For example, 30.6% of the population aged 20-24 living in our republic, 30.3% of Uzbeks, 32.4% of representatives of Central Asian nations, 30.1% of people with incomplete secondary education associate national self-awareness with the national independence of Uzbekistan and consider it an important factor, knows that At the moment, 5.9% of the youth belonging to the Slavic nationality living in our country, and 10.4% of the representatives of other nationalities associate the awareness of national identity with the mother tongue and national culture (47.1%), with folk traditions (33.8%). . In society, the problems of youth education have always been one of the first priority topics of the day. At the same time, the process of globalization is accelerating in the world. Mutual relations between the peoples and countries of the world are increasing. Uzbekistan is no exception. The values of different peoples affect the lives of the youth of Uzbekistan. Such an environment creates conditions for the influence of the international information system, the Internet, mass media, advertising, and various film programs to influence the spiritual life of young people, and for the penetration of various values. Young people should know well which aspects of it to use or not to use. It is important to distinguish values from each other, to treat them without losing national values. In social life, in the behavior of some young people, it is possible to observe situations that do not correspond to our national values. It is possible to observe cases of incompatibility between the actions of some young people who support the ideas of religious extremism and fanaticism and our national values. The events that took place in Tashknet, Bukhara, Andijan show that we have important tasks ahead of us, such as instilling our national values into the outlook of young people and educating them to be loyal to them. Most of our young people have formed their correct attitude towards national and universal values. The fact that they express their negative attitude towards efforts to promote values, especially fanaticism, should be highly appreciated. Today, the attempt to educate young people against national values is increasing in the world information arena. It is becoming increasingly clear what hidden goals lie behind the ideas that a democratic society cannot be built without changing the attitude to values. Such actions are aimed at educating young people in a spirit of disdain for their people, homeland and national values, and they have hidden goals of instilling in them a tendency to more western values. The role of national and universal values in the life of young people is important; Unhealthy bigotry occurs faster in the behavior of young people who do not know national values well. Independence opens up new opportunities for young people to correctly assess universal values by relying on a new system of values, national-cultural heritage and traditions. Independence marked a new era in the lives of young people, and it is appropriate that young people feel it deeply. The goal of strengthening national-spiritual values in the worldview of young people is not to teach them to live based on their own values, but to encourage them to live and work, taking into account that the development of the country depends on them. In addition, deep knowledge of national-spiritual values has a positive effect on preservation, protection and strengthening of independence by young people. This is inextricably linked with the future

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development of the country. In the conditions of independence, national and universal values are gaining their true meaning. It is an important achievement that young people's views and attitudes about it are changing, and national-spiritual values are considered as the basis of universal human value. One of our important achievements in the current period is when we achieved the primacy of national and spiritual values in education. This means instilling in the young generation a rich historical, national, spiritual heritage and providing education based on the traditions of folk pedagogy formed over the centuries.

It is very important to be able to correctly interpret the events taking place in the process of globalization, to analyze each reality based on our national interests and ethno-cultural values. For this, our national idea and ideology must be strong. Resolution No. PQ-4307 of May 3, 2019 "On additional measures to increase the effectiveness of spiritual and educational work" was one of the documents aimed at further respecting our national values.[3] It ensures not to be influenced by ideas, but also forms the ability to respond appropriately to them, encourages to respect our national values and preserve them. Today, in our country, great importance is attached to the issue of bringing up the young generation to be mature and perfect in every way, in harmony with values. At the same time, attention is also being paid to the development of the mechanism of the system of moral protection of young people. Because in the current globalization, on the one hand, national values, on the other hand, modern values implementation of moral and legal renewal processes based on it remains particularly relevant. The Uzbek people have traditions, customs, rituals and ceremonies that can have a great influence on our education, especially the youth, and inculcating them in the minds of children and everyday life in the family today is one of our most important tasks in order to prevent young people from falling under the influence of spiritual threats.

- 1. We suggest the following as the role of ethnocultural values in increasing youth activity.
- 2. To further increase the spirit of respect for our national holidays among young people: in educational institutions, the fact that Navruz holiday is an ancient and national holiday, and the singing of lapars, which means nationalism, should be held as an example of how our women and girls prepare our national dishes together, not only by mouth, but also by example, on the occasion of this holiday, and ensuring the active participation of young people We think it is appropriate.
- 3. It is necessary to teach our national sport "Wrestling", which is considered a national sport, to our young men from a young age, and to organize competitions on this type of sport and to ensure that young people participate.
- 4. We think that it is necessary to further develop our national houses, such as the "wrestlers' competition", which symbolizes our nationality at weddings, and show them to young people. Today, this competition is preserved only in some of our villages.
- 5. Taking into account that the stage of Darboz is decreasing day by day, I think that they should increase their performances. I think that it is necessary to increase such spectacles, seeing that the game of darboz organized in the neighborhood of Gijduvan district of Bukhara region was watched with pleasure not only by adults but also by young people. In general, I believe that reducing the free time of young people would prevent them from falling under the influence of various alien and harmful ideas.

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
