

## Important factors in protecting young generation from spiritual threats in a remoderated Uzbekistan

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**Abstract:** After the independence of the Republic of Uzbekistan, the values of national statehood, spirituality and national traditions have been restored, and democratic values have been developed in the life of society. Huge political and social work is being carried out in our country aimed at building a democratic society and civil society. As a result of globalization inherent in the XXI century, the processes of international integration are developing rapidly.

**Key words:** human civilization, powerful states, newly independent, development.

### Introduction

By the end of the twentieth century, one of the world's political poles, the socialist camp, had disappeared, and the "Cold War" had disappeared from the political scene of history. But in the new stage of human civilization, powerful states are trying to influence the newly independent states or the countries that have passed the path of development in the world out of their own interests.

It is no exaggeration to say that the end of 2020 and the beginning of this year have become a historic event in the lives of young people and a turning point in increasing the effectiveness of work with young people.

In particular, 48 people took part in the Youth Forum on December 25 last year, 38 in the President's Address to the Parliament and 38 in the State Program for 2021, and at the video conference on 27 January, 58 (144 in total) implementation mechanisms and systemic measures with clear sources of funding were identified.

The State Program for 2021 sets 38 tasks for young people.

Including 1 - Law, 1 - Presidential Decree, 3 - Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers and 1 decree, it is planned to develop and implement 10 draft normative legal acts and 22 other measures.

The Agency for Youth Affairs of the Republic of Uzbekistan is working on a number of issues related to youth this year.

It has begun to implement specific measures on the basis of the following two main priorities set by the President:

The first is to ensure youth employment;

The second is the meaningful leisure of young people.

In the first direction:

Initially, an electronic database of "Youth Balance" is being developed in each district (city)

and mahalla. To date, the “Youth Balance” in Fergana region has been fully formed in the mahallas. Second, in cooperation with the Chamber of Commerce and Industry, weekly training courses for young people in the “Youth Book” were organized within the “Youth: “1 + 1” program. By the end of the year, 100,000 unorganized and unemployed youth will be trained in professions and entrepreneurship.

The Ministry of Employment, together with sector leaders, will provide employment to 300,000 unemployed youth this year through vocational training of unemployed youth in training centers in 826 sectors of 206 cities and districts.

### **Main part**

In addition, at least 20,000 young people will be trained in entrepreneurship through an online platform for 15 high-demand professions. An electronic platform is currently being developed in this regard.

Currently, a list of 500,000 young people trained in vocational and entrepreneurship is being formed. Third, young people who have completed the training course and received a certificate will be provided with loans at a reduced rate under family business programs.

Fourth, on the basis of the principle “Every entrepreneur is a supporter of youth”, the responsible organizations for the employment of 100 thousand young people by attaching unemployed youth to volunteer entrepreneurs and a targeted list of enterprising entrepreneurs and young people attached to them with sector leaders is being formed by districts (cities).

In addition, specific tasks have been set for the establishment of “Youth Industrial Zones” in districts and cities.

The second direction is the meaningful leisure of young people:

First, concrete and effective measures have been identified for the implementation of five important initiatives at the district and city levels. Decisions on 5 initiatives were made by the governors of each region and district.

Favorable conditions are being created for young people to spend their free time meaningfully.

Second, together with the Ministries of Public Education, Higher Education, and the Tourism Committee, a plan has been developed for each educational institution in the regions, and trips for 600,000 young people are being organized this year.

Third, in cooperation with the Ministry of Information Technologies, 100 “Digital Technology Training Centers” are being launched.

Fourth, effective use of gyms by young people every day has been established in all educational institutions.

Fifth, organization of contests and competitions such as “100 ideas for Uzbekistan”, “The Stars of KAMALAK”, “The most active youth leader of the year”, “Leader of the Year”, “Students’ Festival”, the week specialized for “Intellectual Games”, “Student of the Year” through at least 1.5 mln. leisure time of young people is organized meaningfully.

Daily, weekly and monthly monitoring is carried out in collaboration with the Institute for

the Study of Youth Problems and Training of Prospective Personnel.

In addition, in order to increase the effectiveness of youth policy in the regions, to ensure the quality of implementation of the assigned tasks, the Republican working group is conducting field studies.

Addressing the identified problems and shortcomings on the spot, working directly with the executors responsible for youth issues in ministries and departments, khokimiyats and sectors, and identifying targeted measures to improve their skills on the basis of a schedule.

It should be noted that our weapon against such negative situations is to eliminate the negative impact of globalization on spirituality, to expand the worldview of young people in the struggle for ideas, to inculcate our national and spiritual values in them, to create a healthy environment in families.

Today, various foreign ideas are ingrained in the minds of our young people, leaving their influence on their mental activity. The abandonment of young people of their culture, traditions, values and the decline of their spirituality is a direct effect of the process of globalization.

In this regard, it is appropriate to cite the following statements of the First President of the Republic of Uzbekistan I.A.Karimov as a "spiritual threat":

"Spiritual threat is primarily aimed at preventing everyone, regardless of language, religion or belief, from living a truly free life," he said.

I think it is necessary to take into account his ideological, ideological and informational

attacks, which are aimed at destroying his spiritual world.

Globalization is also penetrating the minds of young people through various forms. Today, the need for the Internet is growing day by day. It is natural that everything has a benefit as well as a disadvantage. In particular, the Internet acts as a "weapon" for some haters.

It is through this weapon that it is influencing our spirituality and national values. This, in turn, creates a spontaneous spiritual threat.

The ability of young people to perceive the political-social, information-psychological influences, including the events taking place around them, with their own consciousness and perception, to form their own attitude to these processes depends on specific psychological processes. How these processes take place depends on the inner experiences of the person, the development of his level of independent thinking, as well as the formation of motivational and a number of psychological factors. It is known that due to the fact that society is currently undergoing a process of transition, various social negative and positive socio-psychological conditions are emerging, including the transition to a market economy, spiritual, ideological changes. These changes, along with the emergence of a specific socio-psychological problem in the formation and direction of information and psychological immunity of young people, play an important role in the scientific study of these processes. Because, today the process of renewal in the life of society continues.

At the same time, the information space is one of the main factors in the life of society, which

has a sharp impact on political, economic, defense, diplomatic, environmental, demographic and other important factors of national security.

Today, the role of the information space in the life of society is growing in the world, and interstate relations play an important role in the formation of domestic and foreign policy of the state. As a result of the development of the information space, information has become a product, influences the formation of international socio-political and economic processes. What is the "information space", what is its structure, its place and importance in society? – such kind of questions may arise.

***Information space is a set of relationships related to the distribution and use of information in the relevant areas, forming the need and demand for information:***

- ✓ *Important subjects of the information space are the media, mass communications, media holdings.*
- ✓ *Information processes, public opinion, public mood, public consciousness, especially political, legal, economic, religious, moral, spiritual, environmental consciousness - information is an integral part of the space.*

Well-known American scientist Farid Zakaria points out that the majority of crimes in any society are committed by young people between the ages of 15 and 25. If all young people are not locked out of their homes - crimes committed with the use of force will be reduced by 95%.<sup>1</sup>

According to scientists such as G. Allport, R. Turner, M. Rosenberg, based on the results obtained through the study of young people, the study of factors of their formation and development, the activities of these groups can be directed to the interests of the state. The socio-psychological study of young people as differentiated social groups should contribute to the improvement of human relations in public policy.

Groups of different forms of youth are, firstly, closely connected with the life of society and are formed in all spheres of political and social life. The formation and development of these groups is caused by a more internal and external information environment.

It is the formation of the information environment, in which a healthy or unhealthy situation has a sharp impact on the orientation of youth groups in a negative or positive way. From the point of view of state interests, it is possible to carry out targeted political and social activities that serve the interests of the state and society by scientifically studying the complex of political, economic and social factors influencing the emergence, formation and development of youth groups.

**In the process of studying youth groups:**

**The first direction** is a clear analysis of the goals and interests of young people, their problems, the degree to which their political and social orientation meets the needs of the state. Because when interacting with any social group, it is important to know their true nature. In order to protect social groups of young people from information attacks, to prevent them from being exposed to ideological and psychological

influences, it is necessary to take preventive and guiding measures. It is necessary to take into account the specific psychological features in the development of socio-psychological mechanisms of group orientation and the formation of social group-society relations on a mutually beneficial basis.

**The second direction is** to work directly with group leaders. It is known that there are also special information tools aimed at group leaders. This ranges from the abilities and personal qualities of the team members, to directing them in the right direction, directing their activities in the interests of society, on this basis, the formation of a positive psychological environment of groups.

Today, the concepts of "globalization", "spiritual threats", and "social popular culture" are one of the most widely used concepts. This is not in vain, of course. So far, this concept is an important feature of the current stage of development of human and social life, in particular, its rapid change embodies a very intense and complex reality that is radically different from the periods it has experienced to this day.

It is a historical fact that today the ideology of independence and the national idea form one of the foundations of our country's achievements and achievements, uniting the nation as a nation, the people as a people, a necessary criterion for the social development of society. The number of students who felt the need to form a sense of commitment to **reform on a regular basis was 819 (5%);**

The number of students who believe that libraries with all facilities **should be established is 645 (4%);**

The number of students who believe that all conditions should be created for the organization of meaningful recreation in **student dormitories is 494 (3%);**

The number of students who believe that WIFE zones should be created on the territory of the **educational institution is 308 (2%)**;

The number of students who believe that the number of publications containing modern knowledge **should be increased is 229 (1%)**;

**In conclusion**, the concept of spirituality in the minds of students, the formation of secular and religious sciences, the development of national traditions and values among them, one of the most important and urgent tasks today is to inculcate the skills of love for the motherland, science and enlightenment.

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
