The Resolution of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan "On the organization of activities of the Ministry of Economic Development and Poverty Reduction of the Republic of Uzbekistan, as well as subordinate organizations" and The Decree of the President of



the Republic of Uzbekistan "On measures to radically update the state policy in the field of economic development and poverty reduction" mentions the following tasks:

the tasks of improving the level and quality of life of the population in the regions, in particular poverty reduction, are in many ways directly related to the creation of new and sustainable jobs by increasing competitiveness all industries and sectors of the economy and the creation of fundamental conditions for the development of entrepreneurship.

As part of the implementation of this decree, practical work is being carried out to promote economic development in the regions and reduce poverty. In this regard, the Decree pays special attention to:

implementation of measures to achieve national goals and objectives in the field of sustainable development;

identification of factors and directions that contribute to their development, taking into account natural resources and labor resources and "relative advantages" of regions;

implementation, increasing the competitiveness of the national economy;

ensuring sustainable economic growth, the concept of socio-economic development of the country, the development of industries and regions.]

Reforms carried out by the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan, decrees and resolutions on poverty reduction are now yielding results. In this direction, propaganda work is being carried out. In particular, the situation with poverty in mahallas (unemployed, low-income families) is studied, and data is collected in each mahalla. The cases of the population included in the "Temir Daftar" were studied and the tasks were set: to teach the population entrepreneurship, improve their professional skills, study the problems of

unemployed women, in order to support young people, the issues of finding information about young people with difficult living conditions in mahallas, attracting them to clubs to improve their professional skills, passion for study, allocate loans for starting business activities are solved. Their goals are being studied. The problem of unemployed women and youth in the country is being studied in the regions, and the only way to solve these problems is to organize refresher courses for single women and women with many children, the unemployed who have expressed a desire to study a profession in accordance with the level of their capabilities and skills required in everyday life for the unemployed.

In connection with the above-mentioned situation, a plan of propaganda programs and activities among higher educational institutions, districts, and secondary schools was developed to study the problems of the population included in the "Temir Daftar", and is being implemented within the framework of working events.

Within the framework of cooperation programs between educational institutions for further improving the quality of education in schools that do not meet the quality requirements, specific tasks are defined. In order to further improve the education system, the level of admission of graduates to higher educational institutions is being increased, problems of improving the quality of education are being solved by organizing master classes and tests for high school students on the basis of cooperation programs between educational institutions.

In our country today, measures are being taken to support the mahalla and the family, to further improve the living conditions of citizens and the social population of Uzbekistan, to create conditions for the low-income and unemployed population, to attract entrepreneurs and young people to the country, and important measures are being taken to increase their labor activity.
